

Everyone soon to be eligible for H1N1 vaccinations

LANCASTER—As part of the next phase of the Ohio Department of Health's (ODH) strategy to provide vaccine to Ohioans, H1N1 influenza vaccine eligibility will expand to all Ohioans beginning December 14.

Until December 14, state and local health officials will continue to focus vaccination efforts exclusively on health care and EMS workers who provide direct patient care; pregnant women; people who live with or care for children less than 6 months of age; all people 6 months to 24 years; and people 25 to 64 years with chronic medical conditions. Beginning the week of December 14, these individuals will continue to be eligible for vaccination, along with other Ohioans who are not in the high

risk groups.

Walk-in vaccination clinics are being held at the Lancaster River Valley Mall. These H1N1 vaccination clinics are on a first come - first serve basis and dependent on available resources. The vaccination is free of charge. Parents are reminded that children under the age of 10 need an additional vaccination at least 28 days after their first one.

• Dec. 12: 9 am to 1 pm – restricted to Tier One High Risk Individuals

- Dec. 15: 5 pm to 8 pm
- Dec. 17: 5 pm to 8 pm
- Dec. 19: 9 am to 1 pm
- Dec. 21: 5 pm to 8 pm
- Dec. 28: 5 pm to 8 pm

In addition to being vaccinated, Ohioans can help stop the spread of illness by washing

hands thoroughly and often; covering mouths when sneezing or coughing; and staying home from work or school if sick.

The popular gift cards can be redeemed for a number of activities at Ohio's 74 beautiful state parks. They are accepted for overnight stays in most of Ohio's luxurious state park lodges, as well as all state park cottages and campgrounds. They can also be used at a number of state park facilities for rounds of golf, boat rentals and food and merchandise purchases.

Lodges that accept the Ohio State Parks gift cards include Burr Oak, Deer Creek, Hueston Woods, Maumee Bay, Mohican, Punderson, Salt Fork and Shawnee. The gift cards can be used for room rental as well as dining room meals and gift shop merchandise. They can also be used at the public golf courses at Deer Creek, Hueston Woods, Maumee Bay, Punderson, Salt Fork and Shawnee.

The gift cards are available in any denomination, with a minimum value of \$5. Gift givers can also choose from two designs when they purchase their gift cards. In addition to the new on-

line sales, the gift cards can also be purchased during regular business hours at any state park office or by calling 614-265-6513.

Gift card recipients can use the gift card for payment when making advance reservations for state park facility rentals, including picnic shelters and meeting rooms. They can also use the gift card when making reservations up to six months in advance for camping and getaway rentals in any state park campground, or for reservations up to one year in advance for cottage stays at Buck Creek, Cowan Lake, Dillon, Hocking Hills, Lake Hope, Mohican, Pike Lake and Pymatuning.

(continued from Page 9) locations where wary species like wild turkeys and pheasants have been frequenting can let White know so he can be sure to check those places on count day. White would also appreciate knowing about any barns that have barn owls.

There's a \$5 participation fee for each field participant. Observers under 18 and feeder watchers do not need to pay the fee. These fees help to cover National Audubon Society's costs of managing

the bird count program, producing an annual summary magazine, and maintaining the CBC website and database.
